

It's Not Just for Adults Anymore

Read Jeremiah 1:6-7

Raymond was frustrated. To him there was nothing more frustrating than an adult implying that he wasn't old enough to have an opinion that counts. And so there he was, serving on the church committee "because they wanted the voice of youth represented"—and every time he opened his mouth, they give him that look that says, "Well, that's cute, but . . . " It was so frustrating! He knew he had a valid opinion, but no one was listening.

Think About It

What can you do when what happened to Raymond happens to you? Keep trying! Find respectful ways of speaking your mind and sharing your opinion. You and your ideas are important. The same thing happened to the prophet Jeremiah when he was young. He spoke his mind, but people didn't always listen. (But look whose words made it into the Bible!) "But the LORD said to me, 'Don't say that you are only a boy. You will go wherever I send you. You will say whatever I command you to say. Don't be afraid of people. I am with you, and I will rescue you' " (Jeremiah 1:7-8). When God tells you to speak your voice, he means for you to speak. Like Jeremiah, you don't have to be ashamed of being young. The Holy Spirit can speak through all people, young and old—including you! The next time you're scared to speak up, become another Jeremi-
