Sin: Its Consequences

Sin is not a pleasant subject by any means, but it is such a serious matter that we must study it carefully. Today we are concentrating on three of its consequences.

First, death entered the world as a result of sin. In [Romans 5:12](#) we read: *"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned."* Unfortunately, death is an appointment that all men are required to keep. Sin is responsible for this.

Second, as tragic as physical death is, a worse consequence of sin is spiritual death. In [Romans 6:23](#) the Bible states that *"the wages of sin is death."* This spiritual death may be described as separation from God. According to [Isaiah 59:2](#), sin is responsible for this kind of separation: *"But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."*

A third consequence of sin is that it will keep a person out of heaven. John showed in [Revelation 21:27](#) that no sin will enter that wonderful place: *"And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life."* The alternative to spending eternity in heaven is being condemned to a place of torment and misery that the Bible calls hell. Thankfully, this horrible place can be avoided.

Although these matters are unpleasant, we must realize how disastrous the consequences of sin are so we can fully appreciate the payment that was made for our sins.

Developing Young Leaders through the REACH Techniques Relationships

- 1. Focus on students’ assets rather than their deficits
- 2. Build developmental relationships with and among students
- 3. Help students take relationships seriously
- 4. Encourage students to connect with people who can help them grow
- 5. Help students think positively about the relationships in their lives

- Effort**
- 6. Remind students that working harder can make them smarter
 - 7. Describe failures and mistakes as opportunities to grow
 - 8. Teach students to use effective struggle strategies
 - 9. Incentivize effort and the use of good learning strategies

- Aspirations**
- 10. Highlight the long-term benefits of success in school
 - 11. Ask about—and remember—students’ aspirations
 - 12. Help students think forward but act now
 - 13. Help students find their own reasons for working hard in school

- Cognition**
- 14. Help students pause and reflect before talking and acting
 - 15. Help students reframe tasks they don’t want to do
 - 16. Help students develop goals that are optimistic and realistic
 - 17. Teach students to use If-Then Plans to stay on track

- Heart**
- 18. Get to know students’ sparks
 - 19. Tap students’ sparks to ignite learning
 - 20. Recognize and reinforce students’ best sense of themselves
