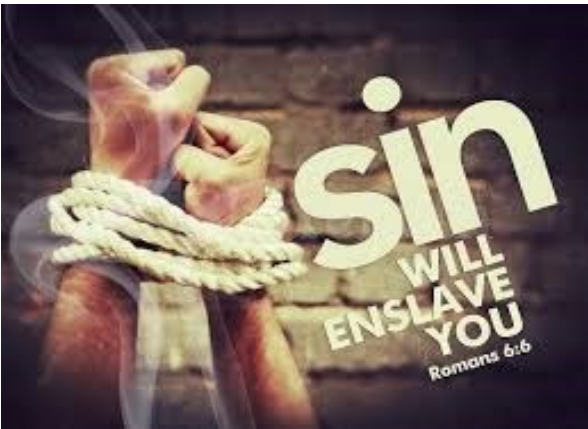

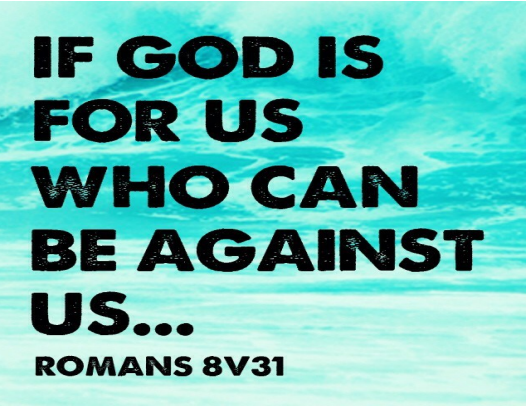

**How developmental
relationships grow**

The research on relationships and the
emerging framework offers fresh insights
into the elements of relationships, and
their role in young people’s growth and
learning. But how do they start, grow, and
change over time? Search Institute is just
beginning to explore the processes that
may be at work.

As a starting point, it’s clear that all
strong relationships are dynamic and
changing, not rigid and unchanging. They
evolve as the people in them grow, and
they also stimulate growth for each per-
son.

Although each relationship is unique, it
can be helpful to articulate how actions
might be intentionally phased across
time. The figure on page 9 illustrates one
potential path, beginning with basic rela-
tionship actions and adding others as a
relationship deepens.

Many factors can alter this pathway, in-
cluding how often people interact with
each other, each person’s relational skills,
the setting they are in, and many other
factors. For example, when we are inten-
tional about listening, we may discover a
need to advocate for that young person to
address a pressing need, thus shifting the
path of our relationship.
