


**What Milestones You Can Expect**

- Young teens become more  
and **more independent**. They culti-  
vate their own interests, preferences,  
and beliefs, including choices about  
friends, sports, interests, and school.
  - How they think begins to shift from  
how a child thinks to **how an adult  
thinks**. This includes having more ad-  
vanced reasoning skills (such as think-  
ing through hypothetical situations)  
and an ability to think abstractly (or  
think about things they can’t see).
  - They begin to have their **own  
thoughts and opinions** on many  
topics—including things they have al-  
ways accepted, such as family rules.
- As they develop advanced reasoning  
skills, they may want to **argue**, ques-  
tion authority, or challenge society’s  
standards. It’s how they practice these  
new, unfamiliar skills.
