**Helping Ourselves and Youth
Learn about God’s Love**

Many, perhaps most, Christians have
a prejudice about the Old Testament.
One version is the abiding idea that
the God of the Old Testament is a
God of war and revenge while the
God of the New Testament is a God
of peace and love. Another version is
that the Old Testament is largely
made up of prophecies of Jesus’
coming, and now that Jesus has
come it is used largely to
demonstrate that Jesus was part of
God’s plan all along. Yet another
version says that the Old Testament
is full of arcane laws and commands
and that these are exactly the kinds
of strictures that the gospel releases
us from. There’s a sliver of truth in
all these prejudices, which is why
they’re still around long after they
should have been put to bed. But
Hosea 11 shows how impoverished
all these perceptions of the Old
Testament really are. In fact, if you
were to advise a newcomer to
Christianity how to read the Old
Testament, you’d best skip Genesis,
Exodus, and the rest, and start there.
