Let the Good and Bad Times Roll

Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-8

"Movies for homework!" exclaimed Keith. His art
instructor assigned three movies to watch and evalu-
ate from an artistic perspective.

The first movie Keith watched Friday night was
depressing. Everybody was always unhappy and mo-
ped around. On Saturday, Keith watched the second
movie. In this one, everyone was constantly happy.
No problems existed, and the characters lived happily
ever after. Neither one, he thought, seemed very real-
istic.

Finally, Keith watched an intense drama. Every-
one seemed happy at first. But then there was a trage-
dy—a house exploded. People died. Others were hurt.
Hate, sorrow, and confusion gripped the characters.
Everyone wanted to either give up or take revenge.
But one woman offered an alternative. Her idea of-
fered new possibilities and restored hope. The charac-
ters began working together and expressed for-
giveness toward the villain. By the end of the movie,
each character seemed happier and wiser than before.

Think About It
What's your favorite movie of all time? Is it happy?
sad? Is it mostly action? mostly dialogue? Chances
are your favorite movie has both good times and bad.
It probably touches many emotions—anger, for-
giveness, sorrow, happiness, pain, and joy. The plot
probably twists and turns.

Your life is probably like that, too. God doesn't
want your life to be one big mountaintop experience
or one dark depressing stay in the valley. He has spe-
cific times planned for you that touch a range of
events and emotions, as Eccles. 3:1-8 reveals. Do you
thank God for the good times that come? Do you trust
God when tough times arrive? The author of Ecclesi-
astes reminds you to thank God and trust him for the
times you experience—whether good or bad.
